


Game board

<p>START</p> 	<p>1. Spring is here! Frogs are busy mating in the pond.</p> <p>Move on 1</p>	 <p>2. Thousands of eggs huddle together in the frogspawn</p>
<p>5. A child takes some spawn. The eggs die when kept out of the pond.</p> <p>Lose 2. Move on 1</p>	<p>4. Warm weather melts the frost. The spawn is growing well</p>	<p>3. Oh no! Frost kills some spawn.</p> <p>Lose 2</p>
<p>6. The frogspawn hatches into tadpoles. They search the pond for plants to eat</p>	 <p>7. A great diving beetle hunts for tadpoles.</p> <p>Lose 1</p>	<p>8. A dragonfly nymph attacks and eats 2 tadpoles.</p> <p>Lose 1</p>
 <p>11. Now the tadpoles have front legs too!</p>	<p>10. An old oil can pollutes part of the pond.</p> <p>Lose 3</p>	 <p>9. The tadpoles grow bigger – look at their back legs</p>
<p>12. Picnic litter thrown into the pond harms some of the froglets.</p> <p>Lose 3</p>	<p>13. The tadpoles look like frogs now. They start to eat animals as well as plants</p>	<p>14. A heron catches frogs for lunch.</p> <p>Lose 2</p>
<p>17. A frog is on the grass when the lawn is being cut!</p> <p>Lose 1</p>	<p>16. Some of the baby frogs are eaten by a hungry grass snake.</p> <p>Lose 2</p>	<p>15. The baby frogs can now live on land as well as in water</p>
<p>18. The frogs leave the pond to find new homes. Some are killed on the road.</p> <p>Lose 2. Move on 1</p>	<p>19. The frogs have at last found a safe place to live!</p> <p>Move on 1</p>	 <p>END</p>
