

Turn an old egg carton into wonderful arty creations – by making some Egg Box Animals! There are many different animals you can choose to make, but why not start by making your very own cute baby chicks?





two beak triangles. Use scissors to cut them out.

Take your yellow card and pencil and draw two long triangles for the wings. Use scissors to cut them out.



Now it's time to attach the beak, wings and feet to your chick. Add a dab of glue to the back of each bird foot and stick them to the bottom of your chick's body. Make sure they stick out a bit!

of the bottom egg segment. With a dab of glue, add each triangle and fold them over to form wings.

Now for the beak! Glue both triangles in the opening between the segments – one on the top and one on the bottom. When you close your chick's mouth, both parts of the beak should meet. Give your chick some eyes with a pencil or spot of paint. You're done!
