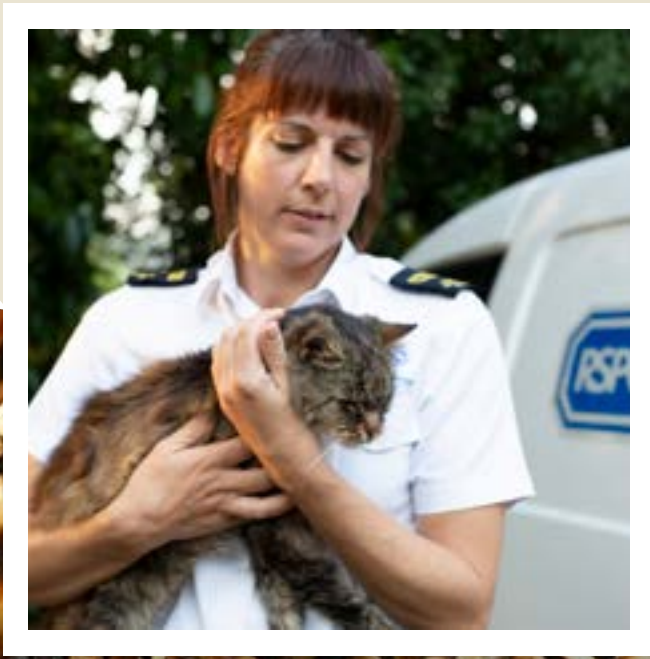


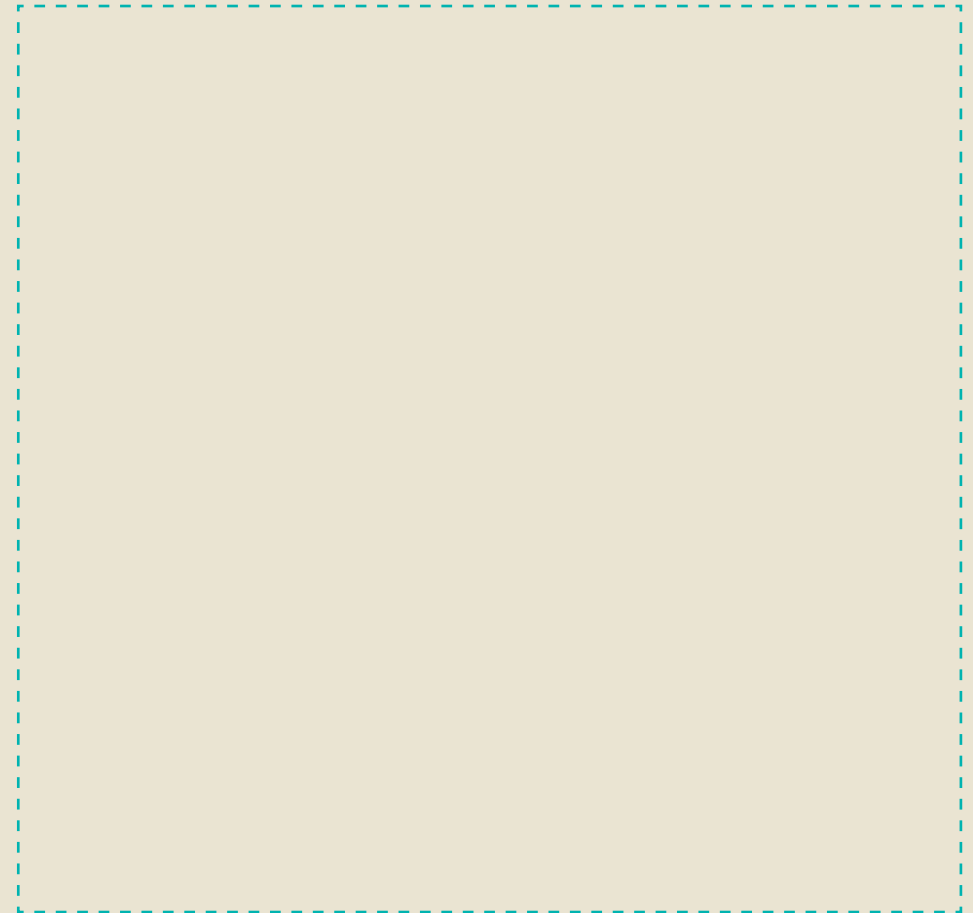

RSPCA Inspectors investigate cruelty complaints
and rescue animals that are in distress

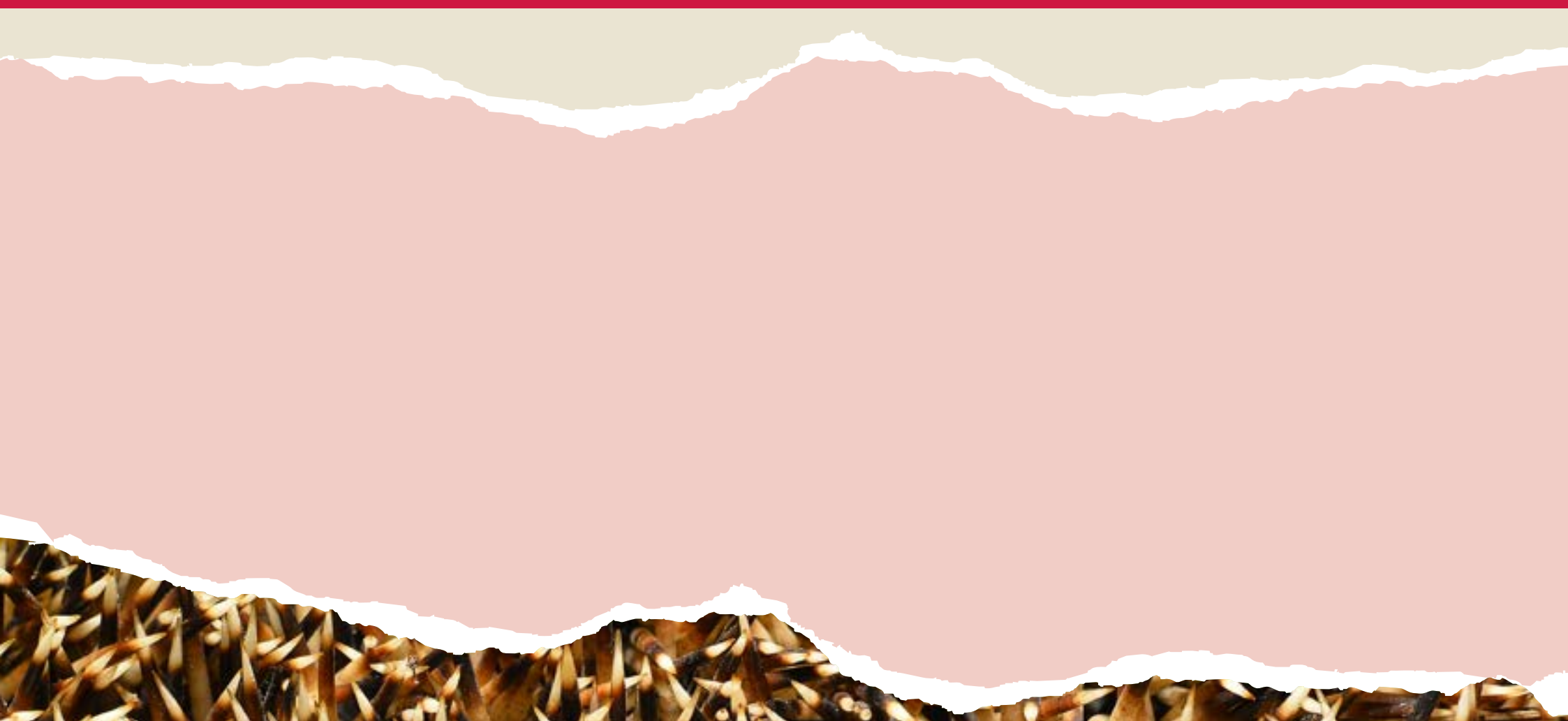
