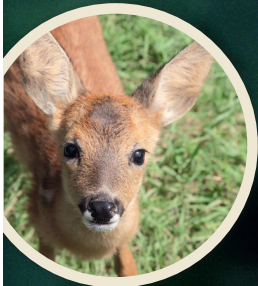




Look but please **DON'T TOUCH!**

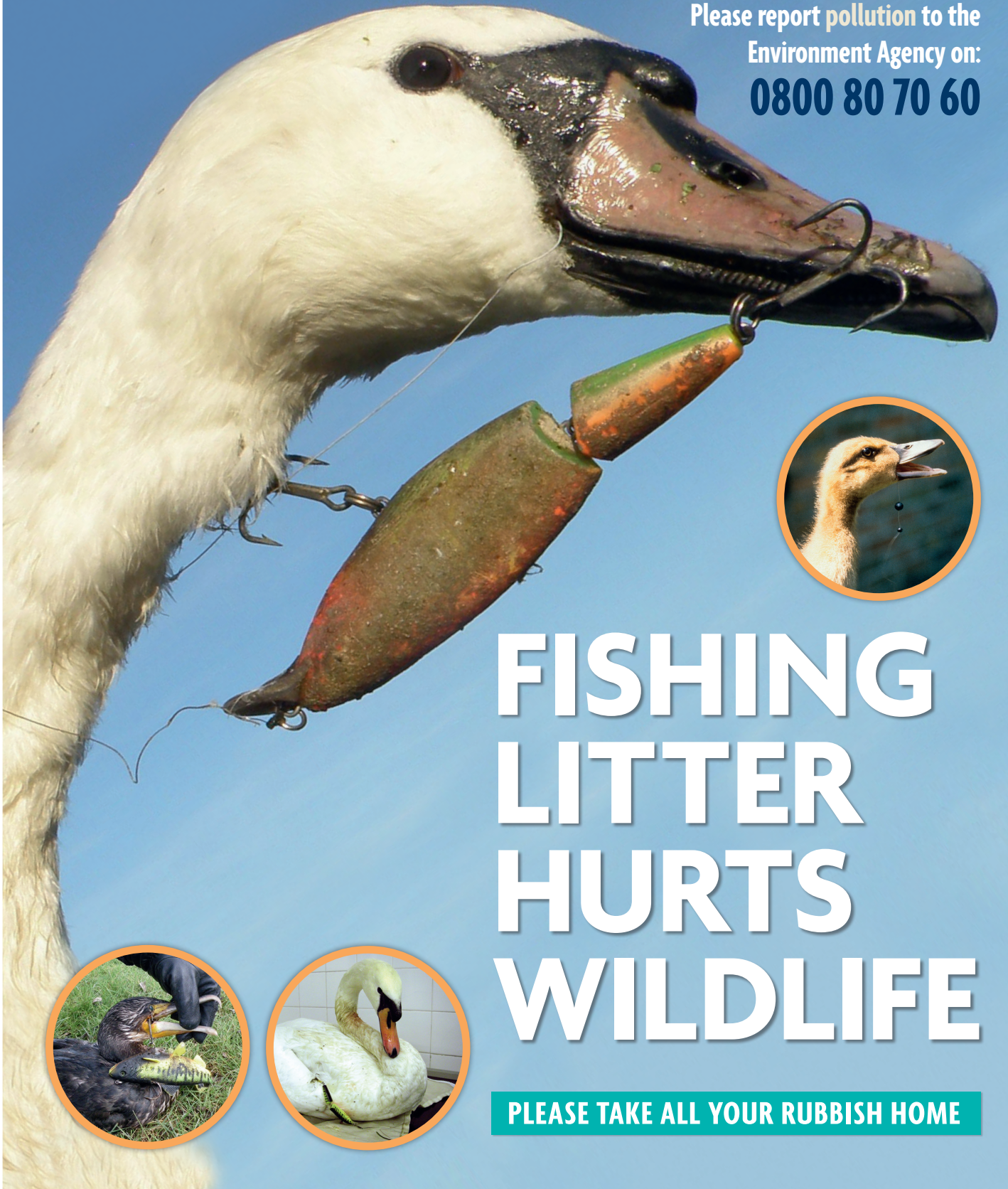
