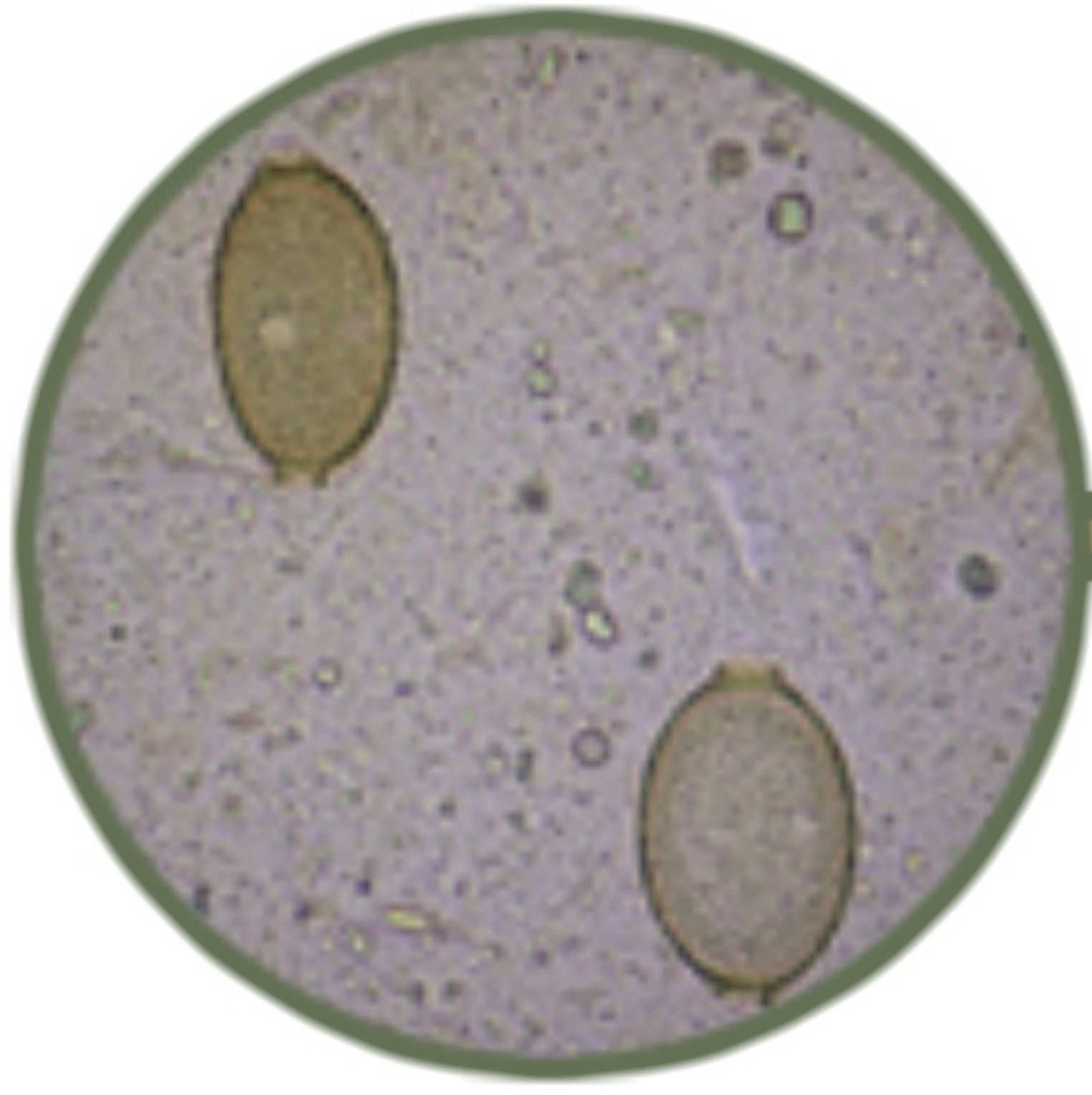




Pictured below are some of the parasites you may find when looking at hedgehog faecal samples under the microscope

Crenosoma Striatum: 70 x 36 µm

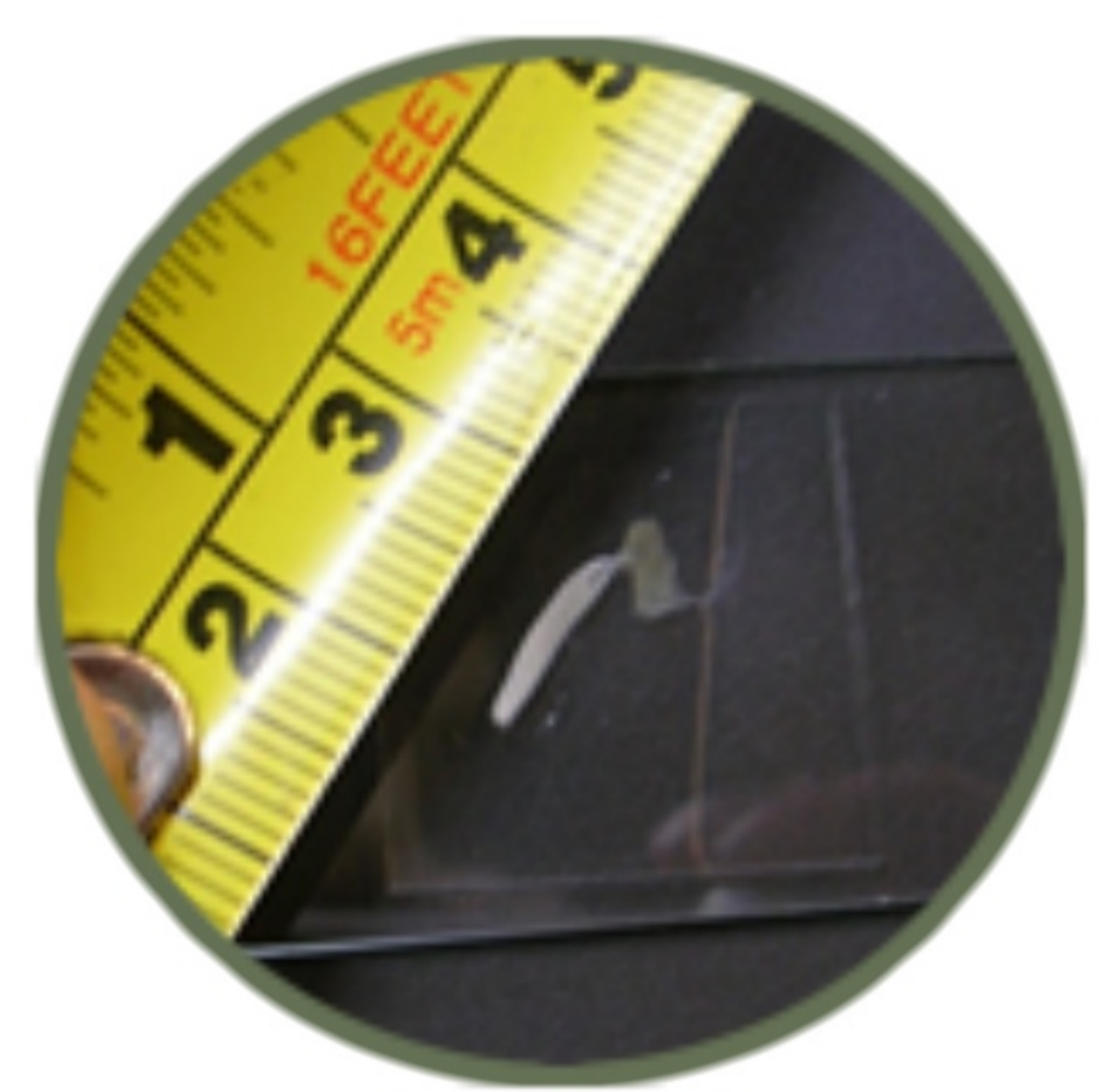
Coccidial Oocysts: (showing a capillaria egg for size)

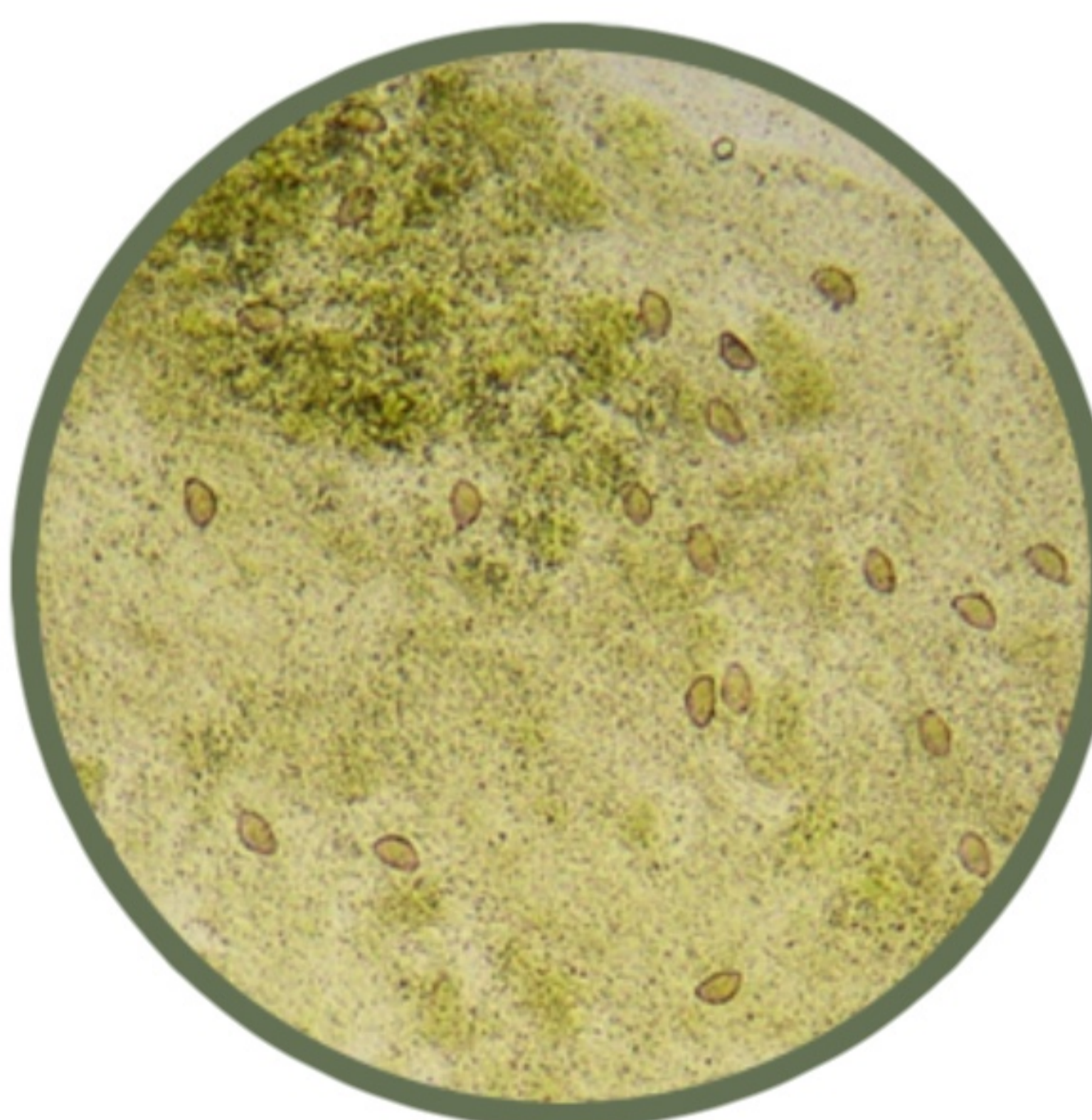
